

# LEX VAN ROSSEN LIVES ON

The Popview + Lex Rossen Award was presented for the second time on the 16th of January last year at the annual Eurosonic/Noorderslag popfestival in Groningen. The award was established after the death of one of the Netherlands' greatest pop photographers: Lex van Rossen. In collaboration with the international music photography collective Rockarchive, the award is presented annually to Europe's best music photographer aged under 35. In 2008 the Dutch photographer Annie Hoogendoorn won the award and this year the Belgian photographer Tom Verbruggen was honored with the prize. His winning photos – and those of other participants – are on show at the Noorderlicht gallery until the 22nd of February, after which the exhibition will move to London (date to be announced).
